The earliest years of a child's life are filled with learning and wonder and carry the capacity for astounding growth. Scientific research has shown that children learn through play by engaging all of their senses. Our program works to ensure that each of our children will enter kindergarten with a solid foundation for success in school and life.

To promote *emotional growth*.

To build self-confidence and a sense of self-worth by allowing choices within limits, and to build in successful experiences.

To provide a warm and accepting environment for the children to work and play.

To encourage curiosity and a sense of adventure with emphasis on self-motivation.

To promote *social growth*.

To promote a sense of caring and sensitivity toward others

Recognition of group needs vs. individual differences.

To promote *intellectual growth*.

Instill a sense of curiosity.

Provide an atmosphere where children discover and explore.

Teach independence by learning how and where to find solutions.

Provide a wide variety of activities with a routine where cooperative play is encouraged. Curriculum areas of art, math, science, cooking, music and movement.

Encourage child to trust their own feelings through exercises such as: dramatic play, practical life, language and fine arts.

To promote *physical/motor development*.

Children will learn to use their bodies in a variety of active ways by participating in fine and large motor activities both indoors and outdoors.
