The Early Childhood Education and Assistance Program is designed to help pre-schoolers develop the skills they need to be successful in kindergarten.

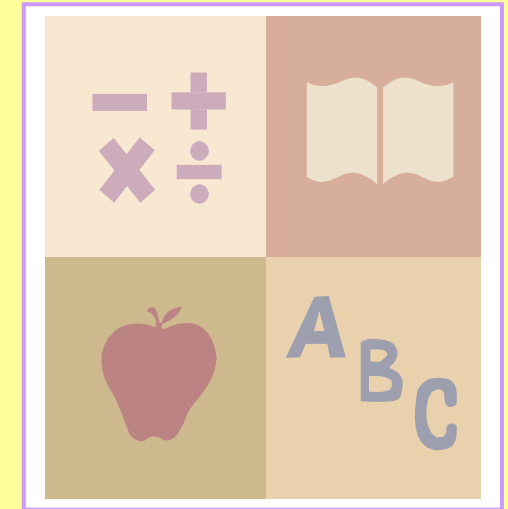
ECEAP PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

- A secure, nurturing environment where each child can develop independence.

CARING FOR YOUR CHILD

- Full breakfast and lunches are provided, along with morning and afternoon snacks. Special provisions are made for children with allergies.

PRIMM ABC's Staff:

- Each room has an experienced Lead teacher who has been trained in Early Childhood Development education.
- On going training for staff is required.
- Periodic Parent-Teacher conferences or other communication keep parents or guardians in touch regarding their child's progress and special needs.
- Staff members are trained in First Aid and CPR for infants and children.
- The center is open from 6:30am to 6:00pm except during the summer when our hours are 7:00am to 6:00pm. The center is closed the last week of August.

- Parent participation is greatly appreciated, but is not mandatory. You can get involved as much or as little as you wish.
